Requests Dated November 23, 2021

- 1) Please indicate how any costs, associated with this project, will be captured by any filing with any regulatory agency (i.e. how will these costs be "rate-based").

RESPONSE: Costs associated with this Project (totaling approximately \$2,600,000, as stated in the Letter of Notification Application) will be integrated into ATSI's FERC-approved transmission formula rates and are inclusive of engineering, material, and construction costs, plus applicable overhead, for which ATSI, as the Transmission Owner, is legally responsible.

- 2) Will the costs be captured through FERC formula rates (OATT Attachment-H)?

RESPONSE: Yes. This is a supplemental project and has been assigned supplemental number s2553. Specifically, costs will be captured through FERC formula rates for the ATSI Transmission Zone, Attachment H-21 in the PJM OATT.

- 3) Will the customer be responsible for any costs of this project?

RESPONSE: No. ATSI has plans to loop the line connection into Delta-Wauseon 138 kV Line.
