MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

Alternative Utility Services, Inc. has been an Ohio Certified Competitive Retail Electric Service Provider, since 2011. AUS was issued Certificate No. 11-230g(5) to operate and provide Aggregation and Power Broker services for the two year period commencing November 6, 2019 and ending November 6, 2021. Unfortunately, due to an administrative error, AUS filed its renewal application on November 22, 2021, which is outside of the time frame set forth by Rule 4901:1-24-04, Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC").
