On November 23, 2021, as amended on December 20, 2021 Logan County Gig, LLC (Logan County or Applicant) filed an application seeking authority to provide telecommunications services throughout Ohio on a facilities-based and resale basis. Absent full or partial suspension, certification applications will be approved in accordance with the thirty-day automatic approval process described in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-6-05. The Applicant has demonstrated that it has the requisite technical, financial and managerial expertise to provide service in Ohio.

Staff has determined that the proposed application satisfies the Commission's requirements set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-6-08. Staff therefore recommends that this application be automatically approved on December 24, 2021.
