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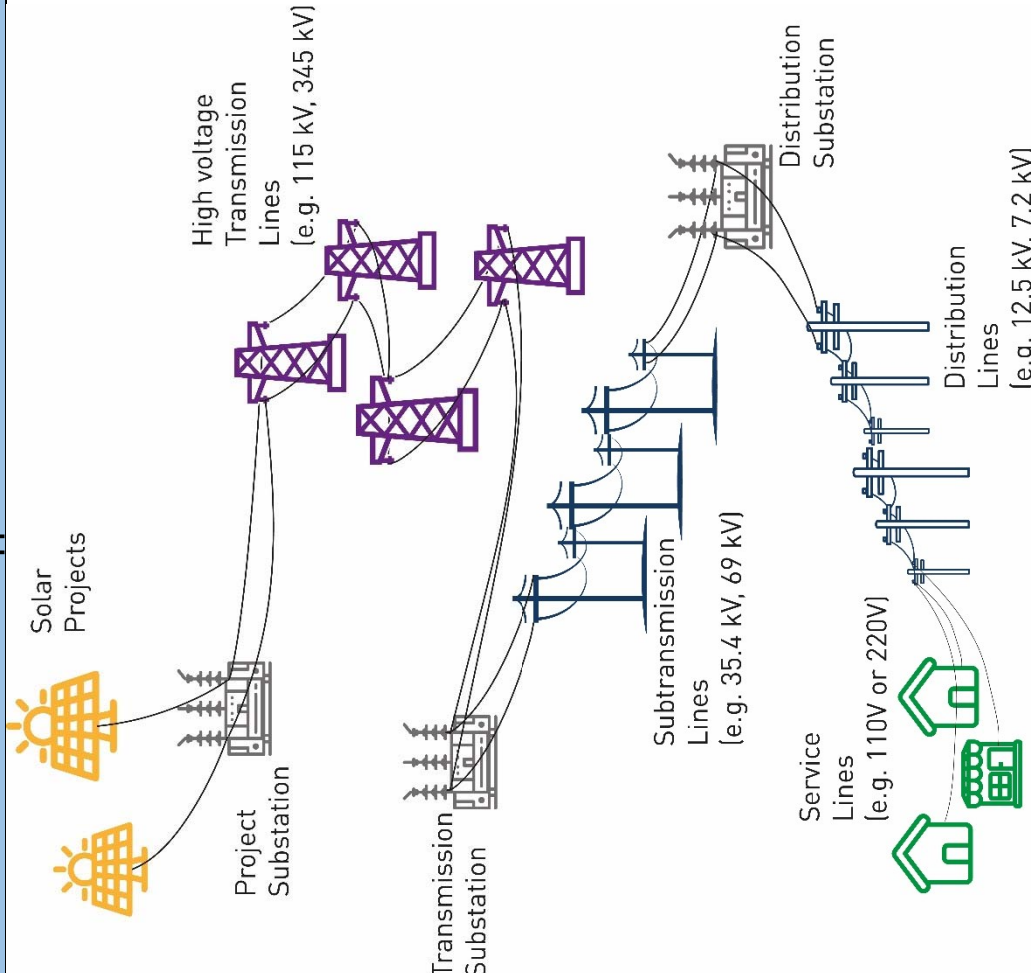

The electricity generated from the Palomino Solar Energy Project will be delivered to the transmission grid (not the distribution system), along with many other electric-generating resources. The transmission and distribution of electricity from a generating source to consumer is shown in Inset below. Electricity is the movement of electric current from the generation source to the consumer within conductors. These electric currents reach their end users through multiple steps, originating at the generating facility, being transmitted over high-voltage transmission lines, being distributed through above-ground or below-ground distribution lines, and then eventually traveling through electrical cords plugged into wall outlets or connected to circuits to the electricity-consuming device. For electricity to be useful, it must be transmitted from the generation source to customers along these conductors. Generating plants (like the Palomino Solar Energy Project) are connected to high-voltage transmission lines that facilitate bulk-power transportation. Before connecting to the transmission lines, electricity generated at these facilities is "stepped-up" to a transmission voltage (e.g., 115 kV, 345 kV) in substations that are close in proximity to the generating facility. Transmitting electricity at these higher voltages is more efficient than doing so at lower voltages because the system experiences few electrical losses. These high-voltage transmission lines connect to distribution substations, sometimes many (even hundreds) of miles away from the generating facilities. The transmission substations contain transformers that transform the electricity from the higher transmission voltage to a lower voltage (e.g., 34.5 kV, 69 kV). Sub-transmission lines then exit these substations and transfer the electricity to other transformers that are capable of further decreasing the voltage (e.g., 12.5 kV) before it is further "stepped-down" for customer use (e.g., 110 V or 220 V). From these transformers, service lines then connect to buildings, including homes and businesses, through circuit breaker boxes. These circuit breaker boxes are wired to provide electricity throughout a building at the voltages (110 V or 220 V) necessary for operating electric devices (e.g., a light bulb, a television, or household appliance).
