{¶ 1} Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Kim Sangseob (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On September 16, 2021, Respondent requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} As set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-16(B), unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or agreed by the parties, a prehearing conference in a civil forfeiture case shall be scheduled upon the filing of a request for administrative hearing.

{¶ 4} On December 29, 2021, a prehearing conference was scheduled for February 3, 2022.

{¶ 5} At this time, the attorney examiner reschedules the prehearing conference that was previously scheduled for February 3, 2022, in order to find a translator for the Respondent at the conference. The parties in this case are directed to participate in a prehearing conference on February 25, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., ET. At that time, the attorney examiner will attempt to contact Respondent by telephone.

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That a prehearing conference in this case be rescheduled in accordance with Paragraph 5. It is, further,
