Community members who can afford to move will do so even though the income from the sale of their property will be reduced. People choose to live in rural communities for various reasons. For some, an escape from industrial cities is their dream. To surround homes with industrial panels on multiple sides of their properties should be illegal. We chose to live in an area zoned agricultural, and after the passage of Senate Bill 52, our elected leaders can once again protect our rural lifestyle.
