**Conditions of Approval:**

1. Placement of equipment, construction material and material stockpiles shall be:

(a) Avoided in the floodway fringe area to the extent possible/practicable at times other than during construction activities.

(b) Prohibited in floodway areas other than during construction activities

2. The project shall be constructed in compliance with the approved plans, any change shall be submitted for approval prior to starting that portion of the work.

3. Temporary work mats installed during construction shall be adequately anchored to prevent flotation during a high water event.

4. The applicant is responsible for obtaining all required federal, state and local permits which are required for this project and provide a copy of such permits to the City of Groveport.

5. Disturbed areas shall be re-seeded and stabilized as soon as possible to avoid erosion during a high water event.

The following inspections shall be requested:

1. Anchor inspection of work mats.

2. Final inspection - at completion of project

The undersigned does hereby covenant and agree to comply with all provisions of the law and ordinances of the City of Groveport, pertaining to same, and to erect and / or modify the structure or develop land according to the plans and specifications as approved. This permit is revocable, when or if facts or conditions under which it is granted, are changed or violated. Any permit issued shall become invalid unless the work authorized by it shall have been commenced within 180 days of the issuance date. This permit is valid for one year from date of issuance.
