I am concerned that this project will decrease property values in the area. This would have a negative long term effect on those that own property around this project. The land being taken out of farmland and put into these panels will impact those family farmers that are currently renting the land as well as the local agricultural economy such as equipment and supply dealers. We currently don't know what materials exactly the solar panels are made of but ones already in use contain toxic chemicals such as lead and PFAS.
