## Entered in the Journal on March 16, 2022

- {¶ 1} Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Trusted Transport LLC (Respondent) alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- {¶ 2} On March 17, 2021, Robert Tyree, on behalf of the Respondent, filed a request for an administrative hearing as permitted by Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- {¶ 3} By Entry dated April 2, 2021, the attorney examiner scheduled a prehearing settlement conference in this matter for April 23, 2021. During the conference, the parties were unable to settle the matter.
- {¶ 4} At this time, the attorney examiner finds it appropriate to schedule a hearing for May 10, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., to occur at the offices of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, located at 180 East Broad Street, 11th floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus Ohio, 43215. The parties should register at the lobby desk and then proceed to the 11th floor in order to participate in the hearing.
- {¶ 5} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-14(E) provides that a respondent who has requested an administrative hearing and fails to participate in the hearing proceeding shall be in default. The rule further states that a respondent in default shall be deemed to have admitted the occurrence of the violation and waived all further right to contest liability to the state for the forfeiture described in the notice.
- {¶ 6} At the hearing, Staff must prove, by preponderance of the evidence, that Respondent committed the alleged violation, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-20(A).

{¶ 7} Following Staff's presentation of evidence at the hearing, it shall be the responsibility of Respondent to present evidence supporting his contentions regarding the alleged violation in this matter.
