- {¶ 1} The Dayton Power and Light Company d/b/a AES Ohio (AES Ohio or the Company) is an electric distribution utility (EDU) as defined by R.C. 4928.01(A)(6) and a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.02, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- {¶ 2} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-10-10(B)(2) requires each electric utility in Ohio to file with the Commission an application to establish company-specific reliability standards. The rule requires that the application include: a proposed methodology for establishing reliability standards; a proposed company-specific reliability performance standard for each service reliability index based on the proposed methodology; and supporting justification for the proposed methodology and each resulting performance standard.
- {¶ 3} On October 21, 2021, AES Ohio filed an application to revise its reliability performance targets, namely its Customer Average Interruption Duration Index (CAIDI), and System Average Interruption Frequency Index (SAIFI) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-10-10.
- {¶ 4} On November 19, 2021, Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) filed a motion to intervene in this proceeding. The attorney examiner granted the motion to intervene on January 19, 2022.

{¶ 5} Also on January 19, 2022, the attorney examiner scheduled the technical

conference for February 28, 2022, and set a procedural schedule for comments. The technical

conference was held as scheduled.

{¶ 6} On March 18, 2022, AES Ohio filed an amended application.

{¶ 7} Consistent with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-10-10(B)(6) and in order to

accomplish the review of AES Ohio's amended application, the attorney examiner finds that

the procedural schedule should be adjusted as follows:

(a) March 31, 2022 – Deadline for the filing of comments on the application by any

interested person.

(b) April 11, 2022 - Deadline for the filing of comments on the application by Staff.

(c) May 2, 2022 - Deadline for the filing of reply comments.

{¶ 8} After consideration of the comments and reply comments, the Commission

will determine whether a hearing is necessary.
