Direct Energy Business LLC; Direct Energy Services LLC; Direct Energy Business Marketing LLC; Energy Plus Natural Gas LLC; Reliant Energy Northeast LLC; Stream Ohio Gas & Electric, LLC; and XOOM Energy Ohio, LLC (collectively, the "NRG Retail Companies") move to intervene in these proceedings as full parties of record.

Ohio Revised Code Section ("R.C.") 4903.221 and Ohio Administrative Code ("Rule") 4901-1-11 establish the standard for intervention in the above-styled proceeding as a full party of record. Rule 4901-1-11 states in part:

- (A) Upon timely motion, any person shall be permitted to intervene in a proceeding upon a showing that:
 - * * *
- (2) The person has a real and substantial interest in the proceeding, and the person is so situated that the disposition of the proceeding may, as a practical matter, impair or impede his or her ability to protect that interest, unless the person's interest is adequately represented by existing parties.

In addition to establishment of a direct interest, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the "Commission") also considers the nature of the intervenor's interest, the extent that interest is represented by existing parties, the intervenor's potential contribution to a just and expeditious resolution of the issues involved, and whether intervention would result in an undue delay of the proceeding. *See also* R.C. 4903.221(B) upon which the above rule is authorized. A

review of these factors in light of the following facts supports granting the requested intervention.

The East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion Energy Ohio ("DEO") proposes a new program under which competitive retail natural gas suppliers would offer carbon-offsetting commodity rates to customers in DEO's service territory and DEO would facilitate/administer the program through education, supplier participation, and validating the carbon offsets. Application at 6. The NRG Retail Companies are either active suppliers in DEO's service territory today or suppliers who may be active in the territory in the future, and therefore they have an interest in this proposed new program.

The NRG Retail Companies are knowledgeable and experienced suppliers in Ohio and in other jurisdictions. Additionally, the NRG Retail Companies offer carbon-offset natural gas products in other jurisdictions. Therefore, the NRG Retail Companies will contribute significantly to a just and expeditious resolution of the issues involved in this proceeding. The NRG Retail Companies will not unduly delay the proceeding – and are filing this motion to intervene timely (no deadline for intervention has been set). Additionally, the NRG Retail Companies' interests are not adequately represented by any of the existing parties – neither DEO nor the Staff represents their interests – and the NRG Retail Companies' interests are not represented by the other entities with a pending motion to intervene.

The NRG Retail Companies satisfy the requirements for intervention, and the NRG Retail Companies request that the Commission grant this joint motion to intervene and make the NRG Retail Companies full parties of record. The NRG Retail Companies' motion should be granted.
