Eric is a native Daytonian with over 30 years of experience as an award winning professional registered and CLARB Certified Landscape Architect and Project Management Professional. Eric's professional experience includes all aspects of firm and project management as a principal in two firms he established. This experience required him to become proficient in many facets of business management beyond the professional practice of landscape architecture. His experience includes policy development, staff hiring, development and management, establishing and managing budgets, IT needs including networking, communications, web presence and technology needs. He has successfully worked as a design team leader as well as a sub consultant on a variety of teams and project types, further developing his understanding of the built environment well beyond that of typical landscape architecture. He is well versed in marketing and sales in order to generate required firm work. Eric has assisted clients in submitting grants for project funding and is comfortable leading community and public meetings required for information gathering and input.

Eric's primary focus of practice currently includes the development of Five Rivers MetroParks park master plans and major capital projects. His career has always focused on and continues to include the integration of Low Impact Development, stormwater management and green technologies such as permeable pavements, rainwater harvesting, green roofs, rain gardens and bioswales. This experience has allowed Eric to focus on broad big picture scheme that has helped to improve the overall environmental and economic health of the local region. Eric was the first to design and oversee the installation of permeable pavements and rain gardens in the Miami Valley which are still functioning well today. His expertise in landscape contracting, interior plantscaping, interior and exterior horticultural maintenance, and as a certified landscape irrigation auditor (CLIA), have allowed him to develop projects that are highly sustainable and at the same time are sensitive to the needs of his clients. He understands the needs of the contractors he works with in order to effectively develop construction and bid documents as well as effectively communicating with them through implementation to reduce and eliminate the need for costly change orders. Eric has always valued and continues to pursue technology as a tool to produce better finished projects. He utilizes Cad and GIS technology to help understand his project sites more effectively. He has practiced in a wide range of project areas including regional, community and redevelopment planning, master planning, parks and recreation, institutional, commercial, residential development and residential projects.

Eric has been active in various leadership positions in American Society of Landscape Architects (ASLA) his entire professional career. These positions have helped him to stay ahead of developing trends happening in other parts of the country and around the world. His political involvement on the national level has also helped to ensure program funding for valuable projects such as alternative transportation and green infrastructure that have benefited a wide range of clients and organizations at the local level. He recently completed serving his second term as the Ohio Chapter Trustee and serving on the National Professional Practice Committee. Eric has served as the chair of the Open Committee on Design Build (Now PPN- two terms), Chapter Section Secretary and Treasurer, Chapter Section Chair (three terms) Vice President of Legislative Affairs (two terms), National Nominating Committee, National Audit Committee, National Legislative Affairs Committee and two terms as the Ohio Chapter President. He has been honored for his service to the profession with the Ohio Chapter Medal, the Ohio Chapter of ASLA's highest honor as well as receiving the Chapter Service Award twice. Eric also led the Ohio Chapter through its seven-year successful effort to upgrade its title law to a full practice act.

Eric is an active community leader and serves his community in numerous capacities including an eight-year term on the Turtlecreek Township Zoning Board. Eric also served the township at the county level with volunteer efforts with the Warren County Regional Planning Commission. Eric is a member of the steering committee for the Partners for the Environment. Eric is active in land preservation having served on the boards of trustees for both BW Greenway as president and for the Three Valley Conservation Trust which combined oversee over 20,000 acres of conservation easements and owned properties. These organizations have helped him understand the methods required to put sensitive properties under easements which will protect them indefinitely. Eric has also served on the board of the Wildlife Conservation Foundation for Ohio, which provides facilities and opportunities for disabled children and veterans to experience the natural environment. He currently serves as a lay minister and has served as the chairman of the Board of Trustees for his

church which included the direct oversight of a million-dollar renovation of the church facility. Eric also has served as a committee member and chair of the Board for Cub Scout Pack 193, and currently serves as a Boy Scout merit badge counselor for several awards including the Landscape Architecture Merit Badge.
