{¶ 1} Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Marc Thomas (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On March 21, 2022, Respondent requested that the Commission reopen his case and requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} At this time, the attorney examiner hereby reopens Respondent's case.

{¶ 4} As set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-16(B), unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or agreed by the parties, a prehearing conference in a civil forfeiture case shall be scheduled upon the filing of a request for administrative hearing.

{¶ 5} The parties in this case are directed to participate in a prehearing conference on April 21, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., ET. At that time, the attorney examiner will attempt to contact Respondent by telephone at the number included in his filing.
