Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 4511.63 the Ohio Department of Transportation, District 7 is formally requesting a railroad exemption at the above-mentioned location. It appears the R.J. The Village of Minster feels making the crossing exempt would increase safety to all School buses and trucks hauling hazardous materials eliminating their need to stop at the railroad.
