{¶ 1} Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Party Palace and Spa for Diva's LLC (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On February 22, 2022, Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} As set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-16(B), unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or agreed by the parties, a prehearing conference in a civil forfeiture case shall be scheduled upon the filing of a request for administrative hearing.

{¶ 4} By Entry dated March 23, 2022, the attorney examiner scheduled a prehearing conference for April 12, 2022. When contacted at the scheduled time of the conference, Respondent notified the attorney examiner that she was unavailable for the conference and requested that it be rescheduled to a future date.

{¶ 5} At this time, the attorney examiner finds that the prehearing conference should be rescheduled to May 4, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern time. To participate in the prehearing conference, Respondent shall call 1-614-721-2972 and enter 451 877 057# when prompted.

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That the prehearing conference in this case be rescheduled for May 4, 2022, in accordance with Paragraph 5. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all interested persons and parties of record.
