Thank you for contacting the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) regarding the Ohio Power Company (AEP) and its application to increase its rates.

The PUCO is responsible for ensuring that utilities across the state provide safe and reliable services. Great care is taken to review the utilities' financial records to make certain that the rates set do not result in the over-collection of revenue.

On June 8, 2020, AEP filed an application to increase its annual revenue in the amount of approximately \$42 million, or 3.5% of their average annual total revenue. The PUCO staff has investigated the facts and issues in the company's application and prepared a staff report, as well as held a public hearing on February 8, 2021. The PUCO will fully examine all issues and evidence presented before it comes to a decision in this case.
