
Notice of Proposed Major Utility Facility

FACILITY DESCRIPTION

South Branch Solar, LLC ("South Branch Solar") proposes to construct and operate an up to 129.6 megawatt (MW) solar energy project in Washington Township, Hancock County, Ohio. The Facility will be located within approximately 700 acres of private land in Washington Township, Hancock County ("the Project Area"). The Facility will consist of photovoltaic (PV) panels, along with access roads, electric collection lines, a collection substation, a laydown area for construction staging, an operation and maintenance (O&M) building, and pyranometers. The energy generated at the Facility will be delivered to the PJM regional electricity market. Construction of the project is anticipated to begin no sooner than the fourth quarter of 2022.

LOCATION AND GENERAL LAYOUT

The general location and planned project layout of South Branch Solar is shown on the map below:



APPLICATION NOW PENDING

South Branch Solar has an Application pending before the Ohio Power Siting Board ("Board"). The assigned docket number for the Application is Case No. 21-669-EL-BGN, and copies of all filings in the case can be located at the Board's website at (http://www.opsb.ohio.gov) by scrolling down to "Pending Cases" and selecting the case by name or docket number. To view the filings, click the case number for the case record.

DATE, TIME, AND LOCATION OF PUBLIC HEARING

The public hearing for this case shall consist of two parts.

1. A local public hearing, pursuant to R.C. 4906.08(C), at which the Board shall accept oral testimony from any person, on April 27, 2022, in a session beginning at 6:00 p.m.

The local public hearing in this matter shall be held in person on April 27, 2022, in a session beginning at 6:00 p.m., at the Findlay Elks Lodge #75, 900 W. Melrose Avenue, Findlay, Ohio 45840. Consistent with CDC Guidelines and the May 17, 2021 Ohio Department of Health Order, unless otherwise specified by the facility, individuals who are not fully vaccinated should continue to wear a face covering and socially distance. Please contact the legal department at 614-466-6843 to ask any questions or request accommodations related to health protocols. For those individuals interested in testifying at the in-person local public hearing, a sign-in sheet will be available at the facility and witnesses will be taken in the order in which they register to testify. If individuals wish to supplement their testimony with an exhibit for the Board's consideration, a copy of the document should be provided to the ALJ during the local public hearing. Testimony to be provided will be limited to five minutes in duration.

2. An evidentiary hearing commencing on June 1, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. The evidentiary hearing will commence on June 1, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. EST, via remote access technology that facilitates participation by telephone and/or live video on the internet. The purpose of the evidentiary hearing is for South Branch Solar, Staff, and the Intervenors to provide evidence regarding the Project.

OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON PROPOSED FACILITY

The public will be given an opportunity to comment on the proposed facility. As noted above, the local public hearing will be held on **April 27**, 2022 in a session beginning at 6:00 p.m.

PUBLICATION OF INITIAL PUBLIC NOTICE

An initial public notice regarding the proposed facility, rescheduling the local public hearing, and adjudicatory hearing was published in *The Courier* on January 24, 2022.
