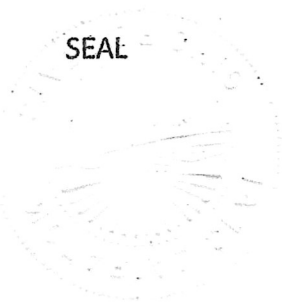

Construction work shall be subject to the prevailing wage rates established by the Ohio Department of Industrial Relations.

Each bid shall be in conformity with the Ohio Revised Code and all bids and certificates shall be upon the forms furnished with the specifications.

Bids in excess of \$30,000.00 shall be accompanied by a certified check made payable to the Board of Commissioners in the amount of not less than 10% of the bid amount, or a bond in the full amount of the bid that substantially complies with all applicable requirements of Sec-

tion 153.54(B) ORC and 153.571 ORC. Any bid submitted contrary to these requirements may be rejected by the Board of Commissioners.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of the Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972 and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

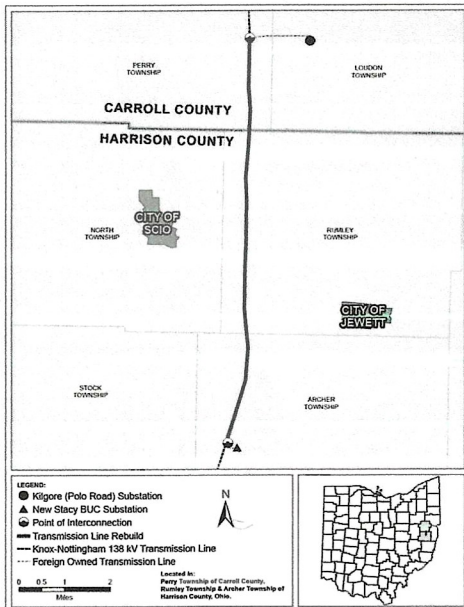

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

American Transmission Systems, Incorporated ("ATSI"), a FirstEnergy company, is seeking approval from the Ohio Power Siting Board ("OPSB") to rebuild and re-conductor an approximately 9.0-mile portion of the existing approximate 44 mile Knox-Nottingham 138 kV Transmission Line ("Kilgore (Polo Road)-New Stacy BUC Segment" or "Project") in order to remediate damage and deterioration affecting existing wood pole structures. ATSI has therefore filed a Letter of Notification Application with the OPSB for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Project. As proposed, the Project will extend from existing Knox-Nottingham Structure No. 2788, the point of interconnection with American Electric Power in Carroll County, to existing Knox-Nottingham Structure No. 2732B, the point of interconnection with Buckeye Power in Harrison County. The Project is located within existing transmission line right-of-way in Perry Township, Carroll County and Rumley and Archer Townships, Harrison County, Ohio.
