Members of the OPSB the following is very important regarding the Border Basin project and residents of Cass Township. The proposed project includes issues about potential impacts to roads and traffic, agricultural land use and farmland preservation, wildlife, drinking water, drainage tile and flooding, property values, public health, aesthetics and viewshed, noise, glare, decommissioning, vegetation management, fencing, and inactive and plugged oil and gas wells. A letter from the Cass Township Trustees expressed their opposition to the project. Specifically, the trustees outlined areas of concern including negative impacts to property values; health and safety impacts; maintenance due to increased drainage, flooding, and truck traffic; and farmland preservation. A letter from the Director of Health of Hancock Public Health expressing her concern with how the project may impact outlet tiles used for household sewage treatment systems. There are 73 homes within 1 mile of the proposed project having septic systems for sewage. Being a life long resident of Cass Township it is my hope you will consider all the residents in Cass Township and how this project would affect us on a daily basis during and after installation. The Border Basin Solar project should be disapproved.
