Entered in the Journal on April 27, 2022

{¶ 1} Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Robert J. Moore (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On June 8, 2020, Respondent requested an administrative hearing regarding the alleged driver violation in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} As set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-16(B), unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or agreed by the parties, a prehearing conference in a civil forfeiture case shall be scheduled upon the filing of a request for an administrative hearing.

{¶ 4} By Entry issued June 24, 2020, the attorney examiner scheduled a prehearing conference to occur in the morning on July 28, 2020. By Entry issued July 7, 2020, the attorney examiner rescheduled the prehearing conference to occur in the afternoon on July 28, 2020, noting that the conference needed to be moved due to a scheduling conflict.

{¶ 5} Since that time, the attorney examiner spoke with the Respondent by telephone during which Respondent indicated that he no longer desired to pursue this matter or participate in this process.

{¶ 6} In an effort to allow the Respondent an additional opportunity to pursue this case, the attorney examiner directs the Respondent to file a statement in the docket within 10 days of the issuance of this Entry indicating his desire to continue further with this matter. Otherwise, at the conclusion of Respondent's time for response, the attorney examiner will advise that the Commission dismiss this case.

{¶ 7} It is, therefore,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That, if the Respondent desires to pursue this matter, he file a statement indicating such within 10 days of this Entry, as stated in Paragraph 6. It is, further,

{¶ 9} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
