- {¶ 1} Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, Staff served notices of preliminary determination upon Stephen V. Towett, (Respondent) alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- {¶ 2} On May 10, 2021, Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in both cases, as permitted by Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- {¶ 3} By Entry dated January 21, 2022, the attorney examiner scheduled a prehearing settlement conference in these matters for February 23, 2022. During the conference, the parties were unable to settle the matter.
- {¶ 4} At this time, the attorney examiner finds it appropriate to consolidate these cases and schedule a hearing for August 3, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, 180 E. Broad Street, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
- {¶ 5} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-14(E) provides that a respondent who has requested an administrative hearing and fails to participate in the hearing proceeding shall be in default. The rule further states that respondent in default shall be deemed to have admitted the occurrence of the violation and waived all further right to contest liability to the state for the forfeiture described in the notice.

{¶ 6} At the hearing, Staff must prove, by preponderance of the evidence, that

Respondent committed the alleged violations, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-20(A).

responsibility of Respondent to present evidence supporting his contentions regarding the

alleged violations in these matters.
