MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

The Toledo Edison Company ("Toledo Edison") requests that the Commission protect from public disclosure the following customer-specific information, which is contained and/or referenced in the testimony of the Toledo Edison's witness:

• Complainant Raymond A. Collins ("Complainant")'s electric consumption history as detailed in his Bills from Toledo Edison.

The referenced information is pertinent to the issues raised in this matter and is contained and/or referenced in the testimony of Toledo Edison's witness John C. Ahr. However, it is also the type of customer-specific information that Toledo Edison generally deems to be confidential.

Ohio law and the Commission's rules provide for the protection of such confidential and proprietary information. Specifically, O.A.C. 4901-1-24(A) provides the Commission may issue:

[A]ny order which is necessary to protect a party or person from annoyance, embarrassment, oppression, or undue burden or expense. Such a protective order may provide that: . . .

(7) A trade secret or other confidential research, development, commercial, or other information not be disclosed or be disclosed only in a designated way.

Pursuant to O.A.C. 4901-1-24(D), the Commission also may issue an order to protect the confidentiality of information contained in documents filed with the Commission to the extent that state or federal law prohibits the release of the information and where non-disclosure of the information is not inconsistent with the purposes of Title 49 of the Revised Code. Here, the information Toledo Edison seeks to protect is customer-specific information that Toledo Edison generally deems to be confidential; thus, it warrants the Commission's protection, and non-disclosure is not inconsistent with the purposes of Title 49. The Commission and its Staff will have full access to the information in order to fulfill their statutory obligations.

For the foregoing reasons, The Toledo Edison Company requests that the Commission protect from public disclosure the documents and information referenced in Attachment A, which is contained in the pre-filed testimony of The Toledo Edison Company's witness John C. Ahr.
