EXAMINER LYNN: Let's go on the record at

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio
has assigned for hearing at this time, Case
No. 21-864-EL-CSS, the complaint of Thomas Gallagher
against The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company.

I'm Jim Lynn, the Attorney Examiner
assigned to hear this case. Ordinarily, at this
point in the hearing, I would ask for the appearances
of the parties; however, I'll explain what the
current situation is.

Mr. Gallagher, the Complainant, called
into the Commission offices probably about 10 minutes
