Background

On April 29, 2022, The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L or Company) filed proposed tariffs to modify its Standard Offer Rates (SOR) Tariff.

Typically, the Company's application includes proposed generation rates for Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP) customers, however, as a result of the timing of its PIPP generation rate auction, the Company was not able to include proposed PIPP generation rates with its application filed on April 29, 2022.

On May 16, 2022, the Company's PIPP auction was conducted, and the results of the auction were approved by the Commission on May 18, 2022, in Case No. 17-1163-EL-UNC.

On May 18, 2022, the Company updated its application in this case to include its proposed PIPP generation rates.

Staff Review and Recommendations

Staff has reviewed the proposed tariff that includes the PIPP generation rates as well as the workpapers filed on May 18, 2022 and finds that the proposed tariff appears to accurately reflect the appropriate auction results.

Conclusion

The Commission's approval of the proposed the Company's proposed PIPP generation are contingent upon final review by the Commission. Staff has performed the final review and believes the Company's PIPP generation rates accurately reflect the auction rates approved by the Commission on May 18, 2022, and should become effective June 1, 2022.
