ANNUAL UNCOLLECTIBLE EXPENSE RIDER BALANCE REPORT

Suburban Natural Gas Company (Suburban) hereby submits its Annual Report of its Uncollectible Expense Rider (UEX Rider). In support of this Annual Report, Suburban states as follows:

- 1. On August 3, 2007, Suburban filed an Application to Increase Rates, which, among other things, sought the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio's (Commission) approval to implement an UEX Rider. In an Opinion and Order issued on March 19, 2008, the Commission approved Suburban's Application to Increase Rates and authorized Suburban to implement an UEX Rider.
- 2. On May 22, 2009, Suburban applied for an increase in its UEX Rider from \$0.7012727 per Mcf to \$0.08641518 per Mcf. In an entry issued on July 23, 2009, Suburban filed tariffs consistent with the Entry, which became effective on August 26, 2009.² Subsequent adjustments have been approved on an annual basis.³
- 3. The Suburban UEX Rider, as set forth in Second Revised Tariff Sheet No. 9, page 1 of 7, states that "The Company shall file an application with the Public Utilities

Commission of Ohio requesting approval to change the rate if the Company determines that an adjustment of more than plus or minus ten (10) percent is needed to adjust for prior period over-or under-collections."⁴

- 4. Attachment 1 details the calculation of the implied change in Suburban's Uncollectible Expense Rider Rate based upon (1) the balance of deferred uncollectible accounts expense net of recoveries as of December 31, 2021, and the actual bad debt write-offs for the year 2021. Suburban reports that there is not an adjustment of more than plus or minus ten (10) percent for prior period over-or-under collections.
- 5. For this reason, Suburban submits that no change in its currently effective Uncollectible Expense Rider is appropriate and that the currently effective rate of \$.0455166 per Mcf should be continued in effect through the filing of its next Annual Report of Uncollectible Expense Rider Balance.
