**NOTICE OF INTERVENTION OF

The Board of Trustees of Jackson Township, Pickaway County, Ohio (the “Township”) hereby respectfully provides notice to the Ohio Power Siting Board (the “Board”), pursuant to Section 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code of its intent to intervene as a full party of record in the above-captioned matter. As set forth in the accompanying memorandum, the Township is the governing body for the local jurisdictions in which part of the solar-powered electric generation facility proposed Chipmunk Solar LLC (the “Applicant”) may be located. For the reasons provided in its memorandum, the Township is entitled to intervene in this proceeding with the full powers and rights granted by the Board and by Ohio law to intervening parties.

Trustee Jan M Fausnaugh moved to adopt the following resolution:

**WHEREAS**, the Jackson Township Trustees (the "Board") is the chief governing body of Jackson Township, Pickaway County, Ohio (the "Township");

**WHEREAS**, Chipmunk Solar LLC has filed an application in Ohio Power Siting Board ("OPSB") Case Number 21-0960-EL-BGN (the "Case") seeking a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need to construct a solar-powered electric generation facility located in part in the Township;

**WHEREAS**, the proposed facility is to be located within the Township, and the Board desires to represent the interests of the Township, including, but not limited to, the protection of environmentally-sensitive areas within this area of the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the Township and its residents for the Board to intervene in the Case in order to represent and provide the Township perspective with respect to this proposed facility.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

**SECTION I.** RESOLVED, that the Board hereby certifies that it is the chief governing body in and for Jackson Township located in Pickaway County, Ohio, and is empowered and authorized to exercise all rights and powers appurtenant to townships, all pursuant to applicable state and federal law.

**SECTION II.** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, based on the Application in the Case by Chipmunk Solar LLC, part of the proposed facility is to be located within the bounds of the Township, an area under jurisdiction of the Board.



**SECTION III.** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board intends to intervene in the proceedings in Case Number 21-0960-EL-BGN on the grounds that it is the governing body charged with the authority to adequately represent the interests of the Township and its residents in such a matter.

**SECTION IV.** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that each Trustee, the Township Administrator, and Township legal counsel are hereby authorized to participate in and/or attend any proceeding before the OPSB with respect to this Case.
