This letter of compliance is filed on behalf of Wabash Mutual Telephone Company ("Company") in response to the Commission's Entry dated May 18, 2022, in the above referenced case.

Company's Tariff PUCO No. 1 states that its intrastate switched access rates for Originating Toll Free Only Access Service, Toll Free Database Access Service Queries and Terminating Access Service are as shown in NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5, Section 17. The Toll Free rate mirroring was established in PUCO Case No. 21-0710-TP-ATA (Docket No. 90-5044-TP-TRF), effective July 1, 2021.

Company confirms that its intrastate Toll Free rates will mirror the interstate rate reductions required by the F.C.C. Report and Order in WC Docket No. 18-156, *In re 8YY Access Charge Reform*, which are being filed with the F.C.C. by NECA to be effective July 1, 2022. No additional changes are necessary to Company's intrastate access tariff to remain compliant with Case No. 10-2387-TP-COI.
