Airus, Inc. will implement the second phase of the 8YY Access Service reductions as required by the Federal Communications Commission's October 9, 2020 Report and Order in WC Docket No. 18-156 (FCC 20-143).

Airus submits this letter confirming compliance with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio's Case No. 10-2387-TP-COI. Airus's tariffed intrastate access rates mirror the corresponding rates of the relevant incumbent local exchange carrier (ILEC). As the ILECs modify their tariffed rates to comply with the FCC's 8YY Access Charge Reform, Airus's tariffed/billed rates will automatically be capped at a level no higher than the ILECs' revised rates. Therefore, no other tariff revisions are required to Airus's Ohio intrastate access tariff (PUCO Tariff No. 3).
