Re: Case No. 10-2387-TP-COI – Compliance with June 1, 2022 Entry

Dear Ms. Troupe,

NOS Communications, Inc. (“NOS” or the “Company”), by counsel, submits this letter to confirm the Company’s continuing compliance with the access rate reduction requirements of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), on this occasion specifically with the FCC’s October 2020 order regarding 8YY traffic, in compliance with the Commission’s June 1, 2022 order.¹ The Company’s intrastate Ohio switched access rates cross-reference to the rates of the incumbent for each territory (either directly or through a cross-reference to NOS’s interstate switched access rates which are maintained at parity with the interstate rates of each incumbent). As the incumbents reduce their intrastate Ohio access rates in compliance with the FCC’s mandated 8YY traffic rate reductions, the Company’s intrastate Ohio access rates similarly are reduced. Consequently, no direct revisions need to be made to the Company’s Ohio access tariff at this time.
