Cox Ohio Telcom, L.L.C. ("Cox") files this letter of compliance pursuant to the requirements of Case Number 10-2387-TP-COI, as the Issuing Carrier of the Ohio Intrastate Access Service Tariff No. 1 (Access Service Tariff).

Cox here by confirms its compliance with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio's Entry June 7, 2021, in Case Number 10-2387-TP-COI. Cox's current Ohio access rates are already set at parity and mirror the relevant incumbent local exchange carrier (ILEC) in compliance with FCC rules set forth in 47 C.F.R. Sections 51.907, 51.909, and 51.911, as well as provisions with Section 61.2 of the same rules. Cox's Access Service Tariff mirrors its Tariff No. 4, on file with the FCC.

Cox confirms that no Access Service Tariff revisions are required at this time, and Cox remains in compliance with the requirements of PUC Case Number 10-2387-TP-COI.
