Dear Ms Troupe:

Ohio Power Company (the "Company") files this pre-application notification letter for the above-referenced Project pursuant to Rule 4906-6-03(A) of the Ohio Administrative Code.

The Company proposes the Canton Central Station Expansion and Line Adjustment Project ("Project"), which is in Stark County, Ohio. The Project includes expanding the existing Canton Central Station for construction of a new perimeter fence and inner fence system. The existing 5-acre fenced area is located on an approximate 30-acre property owned by the Company. The Project will expand the total fenced station area by less than 0.01 acre. The Project also includes the adjustments to four 138 kilovolt ("kV") transmission lines to accommodate the station fence expansion.

The Company anticipated that construction of the Project will begin in October 2022. The anticipated in-service date for the Project is July 2023.
