BACKGROUND

Fox Squirrel Solar LLC (Fox Squirrel) has received a certificate from the Ohio Power Siting Board to construct the Fox Squirrel Solar Project (Project), a 577-megawatt (MW) utility-scale solar energy project on approximately 5,191 acres of private property in Madison County, Ohio. The Project is being developed on private property in a rural agricultural area; however, there are several public roadways and residences in the area surrounding the Project. As required by the Certificate, Fox Squirrel has developed this Complaint Resolution Plan (the Plan) for the Project.

PURPOSE

Fox Squirrel is committed to ensuring that the Project is constructed and operated in a responsible manner to minimize its impact on nearby residents or those passing through the area, and that any community member concerns are addressed quickly and effectively. This Plan provides members of the community a process for seeking resolution for interferences or disturbances experienced as a direct result of the Project.

POLICY

Fox Squirrel will construct and operate the Project in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and permits. However, if residents notice issues during construction or operation, a clearly defined complaint resolution plan has been created for receiving, investigating, and addressing complaints.

NOTIFICATIONS

At least seven days prior to the start of construction and at least seven days prior to the start of facility operation, the Applicant will notify via mail affected property owners and tenants including those individuals who were provided notice of the public informational meeting, residences located within one mile of the Project area, parties to this case, county commissioners, township trustees, emergency responders, airports, schools, and libraries, as well as anyone who has requested updates regarding the Project. These notifications will provide information about the Project, including contact information and a copy of the complaint resolution plan. Drafts of the planned notification letters are included as attachments to this Plan.

COMPLAINT PROCEDURE

Individuals wishing to file a complaint can do so through any of the following four options:

- 1. **Telephone**: The Project has established a "hotline" phone number that will be posted on the Project website and at the Project site: 844-943-0723. Individuals may call the hotline at any time to report emergencies or submit a complaint. The hotline will be staffed 8am 4pm Eastern Prevailing Time, Monday to Friday. Voicemails will be monitored and returned as soon as possible.
- 2. **In Person:** Individuals may visit the temporary onsite management office during construction, or the permanent onsite operations and maintenance (O&M) building during operation of the facility.
- 3. Mail: Individuals may submit written complaints by mail to:

4. **Email:** During construction, email complaints can be submitted to the construction manager. During operation, email complaints can be submitted to the O&M staff. Email addresses will be included in the public notice letters, on the Project website, and at the Project site.

The following information should be provided in any complaint for Fox Squirrel to address complaints thoroughly and accurately:

- Name and contact information of the complainant
- Date of complaint
- Detailed description of the complaint, including, the date, time, and location the issue occurred, and any other details that can help identify and resolve the issue

COMPLAINT REVIEW PROCESS

Fox Squirrel will work with the complainant to identify, investigate, and address any issues that are presented. Initial response to the complainant will be made within two business days of receiving the complaint. The construction manager or alternative designee will be responsible for initiating the review of complaints received during the construction process. On-site O&M staff will be responsible for initiating complaint reviews reported during the operational phase.

When investigating any complaint, Fox Squirrel will first determine if the complaint indicates a potential violation of any federal, state, or local laws or permit requirements, as well as any notifications or required steps that may be necessary to address such violations. Fox Squirrel will also decide if outside consultants are needed to address the issues presented in the complaint. Fox Squirrel is dedicated to resolving reasonable complaints within no more than 45 days, unless extenuating circumstances require more time. Fox Squirrel will provide an explanation to the complainant for the extended period and a timeline for addressing the complaint in cases where complaint resolution takes longer than 45 days. If it is determined that the complaint is unresolvable, Fox Squirrel will notify the complainant of this determination, and provide the complainant with the phone number, email, and address of the Ohio Power Siting Board, for use to further pursue the complaint, if desired.

As an important element of the Plan, a detailed logbook will be maintained of complaints received, the resolution that was suggested and implemented, the assigned point of contact for the complaint, and the date that the matter was resolved or determined to be unresolvable. During construction and the first five years of operation of the facility, Fox Squirrel will submit to OPSB Staff quarterly complaint summary reports by the fifteenth day of April, July, October, and January of each year. The report will include a list of all complaints received through the complaint resolution process, a description of the actions taken toward the resolution of each complaint, and a status update if the complaint has yet to be resolved.

The Fox Squirrel Solar Project (Fox Squirrel) plans to start construction of a 577-megawatt (MW) utility-scale solar energy project on or around August 1, 2022. Construction of the entire facility is anticipated to take approximately 29 months. However, construction activities within any specific area will be ongoing only during a portion of this time. General construction activities will be restricted to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. or until dusk when sunset occurs after 7:00 p.m. Construction activities that do not involve noise increases above ambient levels at nonparticipating residences are permitted outside of daylight hours when necessary.

Facility testing and commissioning are anticipated to take place in November 2024. Site restoration activities will be ongoing throughout the construction period, with final restoration anticipated to be conducted in the second quarter of 2025.

Prior to commencing construction of the facility, Fox Squirrel Solar will comply with all applicable preconstruction conditions of the certificate issued by the Ohio Power Siting Board. Fox Squirrel will construct the facility in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and permits. However, a clearly defined complaint resolution plan has been created for receiving, investigating, and addressing complaints.
