MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

Duke Energy Ohio respectfully requests leave to file its long-term forecast and resource plan five days out-of-time. The Company's filing was originally due on April 15, 2022. Pursuant to the Entry issued on March 21, 2022,¹ Duke Energy Ohio received authorization to file its long-term forecast and resource plan on or before July 1, 2022, to ensure that the Company would have adequate time for proper consideration and coordination of submissions to the Commission, including renewable compliance filings. The Company inadvertently failed to revise its internal calendar with the new deadline and the July 4 holiday on Monday further delayed the Company's discovery of the oversight. The Company filed its long-term forecast and resource plan on July 7, 2022, six days out of time. Given the relatively brief delay and the lack of any other parties to this proceeding, no parties will be prejudiced as a result of the out-of-time filing.

Therefore, for the reasons provided herein. Duke Energy Ohio respectfully requests the Motion for leave to file its long-term forecast and resource plan out of time in this proceeding to be granted on an expedited basis under Ohio Adm. Code 4901-1-12(C) and that the Commission accept Duke Energy Ohio's long-term forecast and resource plan as filed in the Commission's electronic docketing system on July 7, 2020 so as to allow the long-term forecast and resource plan to be part of the record as the case proceeds forward. There are no other parties in this case, and therefore Duke Energy Ohio is not aware of any party to this proceeding who might object to an expedited ruling.
