{¶ 1} Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Brian Jobe (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On January 5, 2022, Respondent requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} Respondent participated in a settlement conference with Staff on February 24, 2022, but the parties did not resolve the matter.

{¶ 4} On April 22, 2022, an Entry was issued scheduling a July 20, 2022 hearing.

{¶ 5} On July 19, 2022, the parties filed a joint motion to suspend the procedural schedule. The parties explain that settlement discussions are continuing and that a status update will be provided by email no later than September 19, 2022. The parties also request an expedited ruling, given that no other parties have intervened in the proceeding.

{¶ 6} The attorney examiner finds the request of the parties to be reasonable. Therefore, the joint motion to suspend the procedural schedule shall be granted, with the July 20, 2022 hearing continued to a date not yet determined.

{¶ 7} It is, therefore,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That the joint motion to suspend the procedural schedule be granted, and the July 20, 2022 hearing continued to a later date. It is, further,

{¶ 9} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
