SUBJECT: Columbia Gas of Ohio - Protest Rate Case

Please docket the associated customer comment and/or attached in the case number referenced above under "Public Comments". This information was received by the Consumer Services Division through alternate channels and is being forwarded to be filed formally. This information is not the opinion of Staff and should not be viewed as such.

The proposed fixed rate increase should be rejected in whole. Going from \$17 to \$46 then to \$80 is unconscionable. It is akin to highway robbery by a public utility. It appears Columbia wants to exit the residential business entirely with an increase like this, and just sell gas to huge industrial customers.

In a fair world, fixed fees for all customers should be based on linear frontage of their property, and distance to their neighbors. A customer in a duplex with a meter 15 feet from his neighbor's meter should pay far less than a customer on a half acre lot 200 feet from the next meter. And they both should pay less than a business 1000 ft away from a neighbor.

PUCO, I call on you to reject this proposal and try to make things fair for

Ohioans.
