4 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Good morning
5 everyone. The Public Utilities Commission of
6 Ohio has assigned for hearing at this time and
7 place Case No. 21-565-TR-CVF and 21-566-TR-CVF
8 both captioned In the Matter of Steven V. Towett
9 Notice of Apparent Violation and Intent to
10 Assess Forfeiture.

11 My name is Jessie Davis, I am the
12 Attorney Examiner assigned to hear the case.
13 At this time I will take the appearance of the
14 only party present in the room, which is the
15 Ohio Attorney General's office.

16 MR. EUBANKS: Yes. Robert Eubanks,
17 Assistant Attorney General, representing the
18 Public Utilities Commission of Ohio Staff, 30
19 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215, 26th
20 Floor.

23 not have the Respondent here today in the room,

11 recess.

14 the record. It's 10:10 A.M. and we have not
15 seen hide nor hair of the Respondent today.
16 So, I think it's save to proceed understanding
17 that he will not be attending this hearing.

19 you can proceed however you wish.

20 MR. EUBANKS: Yes, your Honor. In
21 light of the fact that the Respondent is not
22 here today I would like to move for a default
23 order in our favor for both the violation and
24 forfeiture.

25 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: It will be

1 considered. Anything else or is that it?

2 MR. EUBANKS: Yes.

3 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: So, with that
4 Staff having moved for default judge with the
5 Respondent not having attended, we will take it
6 all under consideration when the Commission
7 issues its order. With that we are adjourned.
