CASE BRIEF

I, Thomas P. Gallagher Jr., at the residence of 8484 Stearns Rd., Olmsted Twp., Ohio 44138, is disputing the accuracy of the meter # S 059 250 948. My case is based on the accuracy of this meter.

The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company has submitted a description of the process of meter testing, but have not submitted an actual report of the meter test for meter # S 059 250 948. There is no proof of the accuracy of this meter. There has been a significant decrease in reported current usage.

Therefore, for these 3 reasons:

- 1.) There is no actual report of this meter
- 2.) There is no proof of the accuracy of this meter
- 3.) There has been a significant decrease in reported current usage

My account should be adjusted to reflect current actual usage.
