- {¶ 1} R.C. 111.15(B) and R.C. 106.03(A) require all state agencies to conduct a review, every five years, of their rules and to determine whether to continue their rules without change, amend their rules, or rescind their rules. The Commission has opened this docket in order to review the long-term forecast report rules in Ohio Adm.Code Chapters 4901:5-1, 4901:5-3, 4901:5-5, and 4901:5-7.
- {¶ 2} On September 7, 2022, the Commission issued an Entry requesting stakeholder comments regarding Staff's proposed rules in the above Ohio Adm.Code chapters.
- {¶ 3} The attorney examiner notes comments and reply comments are due on September 23, 2022, and October 7, 2022, respectively. The Commission Entry inadvertently listed an incorrect time period for comment within the Summary in Paragraph 1 of the Entry. Paragraph 10 and Paragraph 12 correctly directed parties to file comments and reply comments by September 23, 2022, and October 7, 2022, respectively. To avoid any confusion, the attorney examiner clarifies that stakeholders should adhere to the directives given by the Commission within the substance of the Entry, Paragraph 10 and Paragraph 12, meaning comments and reply comments are due on September 23, 2022, and October 7, 2022, respectively.
