A fifth structure will have transmission attachments removed but remain in place for distribution purposes. The structures will be replaced at two locations. One of the wood pole structures, and its associated stub pole for guy wires, is located at the intersection of Pfeiffer Road/Glendale-Milford Road and Kenwood Road. The remaining two structures, and the structure that will have transmission attachments removed, are located along Malsbury Road approximately 200 feet northwest of Carver Road. The Project is within existing right-of-way and will involve structure height changes due to transmission and distribution clearance issues.
