I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} In this Entry Nunc Pro Tunc, the Commission corrects an inadvertent error related to the approval of the stipulation in this case on September 21, 2022.

II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} On September 21, 2022, the Commission issued an Opinion and Order in this case approving a stipulation between Staff, Aqua Ohio Wastewater, Inc., and the Ohio Consumers' Counsel, allowing a return of 6.78 percent for sewer services rendered in Aqua Ohio Wastewater, Inc.'s Franklin areas formerly served by Ohio American Water Company, and for customers in Firestone Trace and Southwood Estates areas.

{¶ 3} Paragraph 51 of the September 21, 2022 Opinion and Order is corrected to reflect that the total authorized revenue increase is \$303,595, which is a gross up of the \$235,729 revenue deficiency to reflect monies for additional uncollectibles, and state and federal taxes. The \$235,729 figure merely represents the revenue deficiency without including the other appropriate items. In all other respects, the findings denoted in the September 21, 2022 Opinion and Order are correct.

III. ORDER

{¶ 5} ORDERED, That the September 21, 2022 Opinion and Order be corrected nunc pro tunc. It is, further,
