**Complaint:**

According to the project's engineers, Oak Run Solar Project will use 10,000 acres to produce the same amount of power annually that is used by 342,000 Ohio households. If you do the math, this project will produce the amount of power each year used by 7% of homes in Ohio on a site occupying 0.07% of the state's farmland! In reality, this is a very efficient use of land.
