On June 30, 2021, Columbia filed an Application for an Increase in Rates pursuant to R.C. 4909.18. On April 14, 2022, the Attorney Examiner issued an Entry scheduling an evidentiary hearing to begin on June 15, 2022. On May 20, 2022, Columbia filed a motion for continuance and request for expedited ruling to move the evidentiary hearing from June 15, 2022, to July 13, 2022. On June 3, 2022, the Attorney Examiner granted Columbia's motion and continued the hearing to July 13, 2022. On June 29, 2022, Columbia filed a motion for continuance and request for expedited ruling to move the evidentiary hearing from July 13, 2022 to August 9, 2022. On July 1, 2022, the Attorney Examiner granted Columbia's motion and continued the hearing to August 9, 2022. On July 28, 2022, Columbia filed a motion for continuance and request for expedited ruling to move the evidentiary hearing from July 13, 2022 to August 9, 2022. On July 1, 2022, the Attorney Examiner granted Columbia's motion and continued the hearing to August 9, 2022. Ohio Adm.Code 4901-1-13(A) empowers attorney examiners to continue hearings upon good cause shown. Here, good cause is present. More time is needed to continue to engage in serious bargaining among capable, knowledgeable parties to determine whether settlement is possible and to finalize the terms of that settlement.

Ohio Adm.Code 4901-1-12(C) permits a movant to include a request for expedited treatment. The parties to this case would benefit from prompt notice regarding whether the evidentiary hearing date will change. Columbia has discussed this request with the parties and can certify that all parties do not object to an expedited ruling on this motion. As a result, an immediate ruling may be issued.

For all of these reasons, Columbia respectfully requests that the Commission find that good cause exists, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901-1-13(A), to continue the evidentiary hearing in this case to commence on November 1, 2022, at 11:00 am. Columbia further respectfully requests an expedited ruling on this Motion and can certify that no other party opposes these requests. /s/ Joseph M. Clark
