Notice of Proposed Major Utility Facility

Grover Hill Wind, LLC (Grover Hill Wind) is proposing to build the Grover Hill Wind Transmission Line Project, an 8.3 mile 138 kilovolt (kV) transmission line in Blue Creek and Latty Townships, Paulding County, Ohio (OPSB Case No. 22-269-EL-BTX). The transmission line is associated with the Grover Hill Wind Farm, which is also in Latty Township, Paulding County. The primary purpose of the transmission line is to deliver up to 150 megawatts (MWs) of electricity generated by the Grover Hill Wind Farm, from the collection substation to the point of interconnection (POI) at the existing Haviland Substation.

Grover Hill Wind filed its application with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) for a certificate to construct, operate, and maintain the proposed facility in OPSB Case No. 22-269-EL-BTX. A copy of the application is available on the OPSB website at <https://dis.puc.state.oh.us/CaseRecord.aspx?CaseNo=22-0269> Grover Hill Wind's website at <https://groverhillwind.us/>. The application is currently pending.

On September 29, 2022, the OPSB established the procedural schedule in this case. The public will be given an opportunity to comment on the proposed facility. The public hearing in Grover Hill Wind's OPSB case shall consist of two parts:

(1) A local public hearing, pursuant to R.C. 4906.08(C), where the OPSB shall accept written or oral testimony from any person on December 5, 2022, at 6:00 p.m., at Grover Hill Elementary School, 101 Monroe Street, Grover Hill, OH 45849.

(2) An adjudicatory hearing commencing on January 12, 2023, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., Hearing Room 11-D, at the offices of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

Attendees at the local public hearing and the adjudicatory hearing should follow the most recent CDC and/or local health authority and/or local health authority guidelines. Please contact the legal department at 614-466-6843 to ask any questions or request accommodations related to health protocols.

For those individuals interested in testifying at the local public hearing, a sign-in sheet will be available at the facility and witnesses will be taken in the order in which they register to testify. If individuals wish to supplement their testimony with an exhibit for the Board's consideration, a copy of the document should be provided to the administrative law judge during the local public hearing. Testimony to be provided will be limited to five minutes in duration.

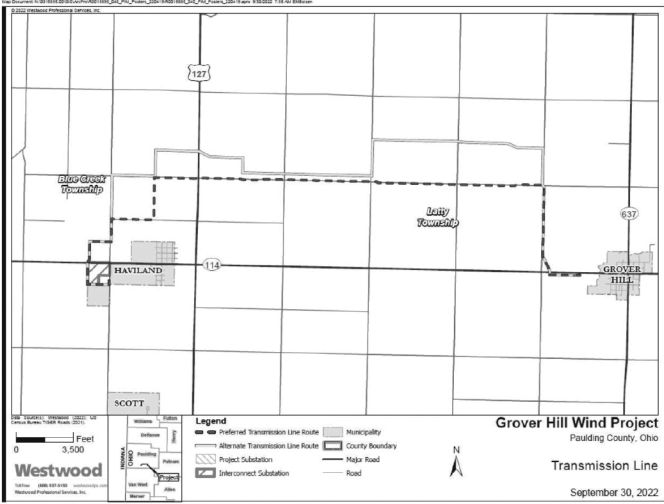

In reviewing an application to construct, operate, and maintain a generation facility, such as the facility proposed by Grover Hill Wind, the OPSB considers the following criteria set forth in Ohio Revised Code (R.C.) 4906.10(A): (1) The nature of the probable environmental impact; (2) That the facility represents the minimum adverse environmental impact, considering the state of available technology and the nature and economics of the various alternatives, and other pertinent considerations; (3) That the facility is consistent with regional plans for expansion of the electric power grid of the electric systems serving this state and interconnected utility systems and that the facility will serve the interests of electric system economy and reliability; (4) That the facility will comply with R.C. 3704, 3734, and 6111 and all rules and standards adopted under those chapters and under R.C. 1501.33, 1501.34, and 4561.32; (5) That the facility will serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity; (6) What the facility's impact will be on the viability as agricultural land of any land in an existing agricultural district established under R.C. 929 that is located within the site and alternative site of the proposed major utility facility; and (7) That the facility incorporates maximum feasible water conservation practices as determined by the OPSB, considering available technology and the nature and economics of the various alternatives.

R.C. 4906.07(C) provides that the chairperson of the OPSB shall cause each application filed with the OPSB to be investigated and shall, not less than 15 days prior to the date any application is set for hearing submit a written report to the OPSB and to the applicant. A copy of such report shall be made available to any person upon request. Such report shall set forth the nature of the investigation, and shall contain recommended findings with regard to R.C. 4906.10(A) and shall become part of the record and served upon all parties to the proceeding.

In accordance with R.C. 4906.08(C), the OPSB shall accept written or oral testimony from any person at the public hearing, but the right to call and examine witnesses shall be reserved for parties. However, the OPSB may adopt rules to exclude repetitive, immaterial, or irrelevant testimony. Petitions to intervene in the adjudicatory hearing will be accepted by the OPSB up to 30 days following service of the notice required by Ohio Adm. Code 4906-3-09. However, the OPSB strongly encourages interested persons who wish to intervene in the adjudicatory hearing to file their petitions as soon as possible. Petitions should be addressed to Docketing Division, the Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E. Broad St., Columbus, OH 43215-3793 and cite Case No. 22-269-EL-BTX.
