A respondent in default shall be deemed to have admitted the occurrence of the violation and waived all further right to contest liability for the forfeiture proposed in the notice of preliminary determination or to contest the making of the compliance order described in the notice of preliminary determination.

And in this case, your Honor, the respondent requested an administrative hearing on July 28th, 2021. He was issued a notice of preliminary determination on July 20th, and in that notice of preliminary determination, it was proposed that he was in violation of 49393.75(A)(3), a flat tire violation or low
