Re: PUCO Case No. 22-231-RR-FED- In the Matter of a Request for the Installation of Active Warning Devices at the Columbus & Ohio River Railroad Crossing, Gibbard Avenue, DOT#515-129C, in Franklin County, Ohio.

On November 15, 2019, the Ohio Rail Development Commission (ORDC) authorized funding for Columbus & Ohio River Railroad (CUOH) to install lights and gates at Gibbard Avenue, DOT#515-129C, grade crossing in Franklin County, Ohio. The crossing was surveyed, on July 12, 2019, and was found to warrant the upgrades.

On April 6, 2022, the Commission approved the project and ordered completion by January 6, 2023.

On October 10, 2022, CUOH filed for a 6-month extension until July 6, 2023. In the request, CUOH stated their supplier has indicated their equipment needed to finish the project will not be available until sometime in January of 2023.

Staff has discussed this issue with ORDC, and they are supportive of the 6 month extension request due to supply issues impacting rail projects. Staff notes that CUOH has kept staff apprised of the supply issue. Staff finds that CUOH is working to complete this project. Staff recommends the extension request be approved.
