Pursuant to the Finding and Order issued on September 9, 2020, and the Second Finding and Order issued on November 17, 2021 in the above-captioned case, the Suburban Natural Gas Company (Suburban) hereby files the attached Second Revised Sheet No. 9-A. Suburban submitted its Second Supplemental Application to Adjust its Tax Cuts and Jobs Act Credit Rider (Rider TCJA) on September 16, 2022. Commission Staff issued a Staff Report on September 26, 2022, which recommended approval of Suburban's Second Supplemental Application. The Commission's Second Finding and Order held that future proposed updates to Suburban's Rider TCJA will be automatically approved after 45 days from the date of the tariff filing subject to Staff recommendations.
