1	1.	Q.	Please state your name and business address.
2		A.	My name is Andrew Conway, and my business address is 180 East Broad
3			Street, Columbus, OH 43215.
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5	2.	Q.	By whom are you employed and what is your position?
6		A.	I am employed by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) as a
7			Utility Specialist II within the Power Siting Department.
8			
9	3.	Q.	Please describe your job title and duties.
10		A.	As a Utility Specialist II focusing on engineering in the Power Siting
11			Department, I review technical issues associated with energy infrastructure
12			design, construction, and operation. I work as a case lead or as a specialist
13			in assigned technical areas of Applications for a Certificate of
14			Environmental Compatibility and Public Need to construct major utility
15			facilities and economically significant wind farms. I also perform other
16			duties as assigned.
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18			I have provided analysis on multiple projects, including wind farms, solar
19			farms, natural gas pipelines, electric transmission lines and substations, and
20			natural gas combined cycle power plants submitted to the Ohio Power
21			Siting Board (Board). I have also inspected and visited numerous power

plants in various stages of design, construction, and operation.

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2	4.	Q.	Would you please summarize your educational background and work
3			experience?
4		A.	I have a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemical Engineering and minor in
5			Chemistry from the University of Toledo. I am also a registered
6			professional engineer in the State of Ohio. I attended a Solar Photovoltaic
7			Project Design and Development training workshop in August 2016. I
8			successfully completed the Electronics Technicians Association (ETA)
9			certified 5-day Photovoltaic Level 1 Design/Installation Course in January
10			2017. I also attended the Battery Storage Workshop offered by Ascend
11			Analytics, Inc. I also took training courses specific to geotechnical
12			exploration, renewable energy installation, and safety.
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14			From 2001 to 2009, I was employed by the Ohio Environmental Protection
15			Agency as an environmental specialist. From 2009 to present, I have been
16			employed in my current position at the PUCO.

18	5.	Q.	Have you testified in prior proceedings before the Ohio Power Siting
19			Board?

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- 1 6. Q. What is the purpose of your testimony in this proceeding?
- A. I am sponsoring the Staff Report of Investigation (Staff Report) that was
- filed in the docket of this case on October 3, 2022. I managed the Staff
- 4 investigation and preparation of the Staff Report in this case.

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- 6 7. Q. What kind of case is this?
- A. In this case, the AEP Ohio Transmission Company, Inc. (Applicant)
- 8 proposes to construct, own, operate, and maintain the Groves Road-
- 9 Shannon 138 kV electric transmission line facility located in Blacklick
- Estates, the City of Columbus, the Village of Brice, Madison township, and
- 11 Truro township in southeast Franklin County, Ohio. The total length of the
- project is approximately five to 6.6 miles, depending upon the route
- selected.

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- 8. Q. Please summarize Staff's investigation that was conducted in this case.
- A. Staff's investigation included reviewing the application, conducting site
- visits to the proposed facility location, acquiring additional information
- from the Applicant, obtaining input from state agencies that compose the
- Board along with other relevant state and federal agencies, and preparing
- the Staff Report that presents Staff's analysis, conclusions, and
- recommendations. As a result of Staff's investigation, Staff recommends

that the Board approve the Preferred Route as presented in the application,

subject to the 22 conditions that are presented in the Staff Report.

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- 4 9. Q. What impacts did Staff review for the project in arriving at this conclusion?
- 5 A. Staff reviewed various types of land use impacts including residential, 6 recreational, institutional, ecological, cultural resources, agricultural, 7 transportation, and overall geological suitability. Staff also reviewed the 8 financial, environmental and ecological impacts, noise impacts, safety, 9 basis of need for the project, and aesthetic impacts of the project. Staff also analyzed whether the proposed electric transmission line is consistent with 10 11 regional plans for expansion of the electric power grid serving this state and that this facility would serve the interests of electric system economy and 12
