Thanks for reaching out to me. I do understand that Pizzuti (and many others) have used NEP in the past. Earlier this year, AEP Ohio filed a complaint with the PUCO around the business practices of NEP and other sub-metering companies and hold the positon that they are acting as a public utility. And as such, they should be treated as a public utility. NEP had filed a motion to have the case dismissed, but the Supreme Court of Ohio recently denied the dismissal and requested the PUCO finish in the investigation to determine if they do in fact have jurisdiction over them.

If the PUCO determines that NEP is acting as a public utility, then they may be decided that it is unlawful for NEP to operate in AEP Ohio's service territory under the Certified Territory Act and numerous other statutes and Commission regulations. Not sure where this case is going to go, but just wanted to make you aware of it and that it could lead to some changes down the road.

Please note that AEP Ohio would like the opportunity to sub-meter this project, and all future projects. In addition, we would also like to understand the reasons why you've used a 3rd party and not have AEP Ohio do the individual metering. Can you give and specifics that might help us going forward?
