Considering several Solar projects being denied due to Public Opposition and other factors, I am requesting that the OPSB take this in consideration regarding the projects in Cass and Washington Twp to be determined as such this category. To reiterate our County and Local objection to the projects:

The Village of Arcadia serving both Townships is in opposition.

Local Fire Department and Health Department had objections and concerns toward these projects.

Numerous individuals gave testimony and reasons why these projects should NOT be approved on record.

County Commissioners voted for exclusionary zones in 16 out of 17 townships representing the entire county. (Solar companies canvassing the Findlay and local villages could not raise enough support to reverse the decision approved by the Commissioners.)

The township trustees in both townships oppose this project

These entities are indeed reasonable support for Public Opposition as well as other overwhelming pertinent information established and provided in the proceedings of these projects that should promote denial.
