1	А.	Beginning in August 2020, I was employed by Alpha-Rae Personnel, Inc.
2		and assigned as a contractor to the PUCO. My duties included writing the
3		Project Description and Need section of the accelerated Cases and the
4		Electric Grid portion of the Staff Report of Investigation for major Solar
5		Facility Projects. I have been working directly with the PUCO since August
6		2021. My duties continue to be the writing of the Project Description and
7		Need section of the accelerated Cases and the Electric Grid section and
8		now the Wind Velocity section of the Staff Reports of Investigation for
9		major Solar Facility Projects. From March 2002 until May 2018, I was an
10		Adjunct Instructor and a Tutor in Physics, Engineering Fundamentals, and
11		Natural Science at Columbus State Community College. The Fisher
12		College of Business utilized me as an Adjunct Instructor in Statistics from
13		January 2005 until December 2006. At American Electric Power from
14		December 1984 until February 2002, I was involved in Technical
15		Assessment and Analysis of Nuclear, Coal-fired, and Hydroelectric Plants
16		on the AEP System. These responsibilities involved considerable computer
17		programming, and some additional programming activities involved
18		preparations for what has become known as Y2K. I was also an engineer
19		with the Philadelphia Electric Company doing nuclear core analysis,
20		refueling requirements, control rod sequencing reviews, spent fuel handling
21		and storage, and analysis of radiation shielding requirements from July
22		1978 until August 1981. As a graduate student, in 1981 through 1982, I was

1			an instructor in the Shift Technical Advisor program for the proposed
2			Zimmer Nuclear Station near Cincinnati, Ohio.

4	5.	Q.	Have you testified in prior proceedings before the Ohio Power Siting Board?
5		A.	Yes.
6			
7	6.	Q.	What is the purpose of your testimony in this proceeding?
8		A.	I served as the Staff Project Lead for the investigation that resulted in the
9			Staff Report of Investigation (Staff Report) which was filed May 10, 2022.
10			I am also sponsoring a portion of the Staff Report of Investigation. I
11			prepared the Electric Grid section, the Wind Velocity section, and the
12			Minimum Adverse Environmental Impact section of the Staff Report.
13			
14	7.	Q.	Please briefly describe this case.
15		A.	The Applicant has proposed to develop, construct, and operate a solar
16			powered facility having a nameplate power output of 110 MW to be located
17			in Wayne Township, Pickaway County, Ohio.
18			
19	8.	Q.	Please summarize Staff's investigation that was conducted in this case.
20		A.	Staff's investigation included reviewing the application, conducting a site
21			visit to the proposed facility location, acquiring additional information from
22			the Applicant, the public, county commissioners and township trustees,

1			obtaining input from State agencies that comprise the Board, and other
2			relevant state and federal agencies, followed by the preparation of the Staff
3			Report which represents Staff's analysis, conclusions, and
4			recommendations. In this case, Staff recommended denial of the
5			Applicant's request for a certificate of environmental compatibility and
6			public need, due to its inability to establish one of the eight statutory
7			criteria. Specifically, Staff recommends the Board find the Applicant has
8			failed to establish whether the facility would serve the public interest,
9			convenience, and necessity as required under R.C. 4906.10(A)(6).
10			
11	9.	Q.	What was the basis for Staff's recommendation that the Board deny the
12			Applicant's request for a certificate of environmental compatibility and
13			public need?

11		A.	Yes. I am responsible for the standard Conditions (1), (2), (3), (6), (13),
12			(14), (15), (17), and (18), the installation, construction, commencement of
13			operation, changes in the facility layout, validation of certificate, filing of
14			beginning and completion of construction, and permitting.
15			
16	13.	Q.	Do you have any edits to the Staff Report?
17		A.	Yes, the Condition (13) is a duplicate of Condition (6) and it should be
18			omitted.

20	14.	Q.	Does this conclude your testimony?

A. Yes, it does. However, I reserve the right to submit supplemental testimony
 as new information subsequently becomes available or in response to
